With a history spanning more than 110 years, over 1,800 members, 16 sub-associations, and 160 student houses, the Rotterdamsch Studenten Corps and the Rotterdamse Vrouwelijke Studenten Vereniging (RSC/RVSV) is the oldest, largest, and most prominent student association in Rotterdam. RSC/RVSV has many customs and traditions that shape student life within the association. Through year clubs, fraternities, and social groups — each with its own unique character — RSC/RVSV fosters friendships that last a lifetime. As a first-year student, your student life at RSC/RVSV begins immediately: you will meet many new people, form a year club, live in a student house, and perhaps even join a fraternity or social group. Every Monday, female members have “club dinner” with their year club, after which they can enjoy drinks in the sociëteit and end the evening in our very own student nightclub, Bikini! Every other Wednesday there is an all-female evening. The sociëteit is also open on Thursdays for social evenings, and on Fridays — weather permitting — you can often enjoy drinks on our terrace or stop by Bikini for a fun night out.

RSC/RVSV is not only centered around social drinks and parties; there are also countless opportunities in the fields of organization and leadership. Study, career development, and social involvement are highly valued within our association, and there are many ways to develop yourself in these areas. As a member of RSC/RVSV, you can join any of the 16 sub-associations that are active in sports, theatre, and music — including our very own Hermes House Band. In addition, you can participate in one of the many committees within the association, helping to organize parties, festivals, and other events. In this way, you can develop unique skills that will prove valuable later in life, while also meeting many new people along the way.

During the Eureka week, you are more than welcome to visit our terrace from 2:00 PM onwards to meet our members and experience the atmosphere of the association. In addition, you will have the opportunity to stay at one of our 160 association houses, allowing you to experience what it is like to live in a student house. During the Eureka week, you can relax, sleep, eat, and enjoy drinks there! We will already give you a preview of the Eureka week on June 26, 2026, when the closing party of our sociëteit will take place — and everyone is welcome to join! This gives us something to look forward to as we prepare for the most fun week of the year.

We do not believe in that. Instead, there is a familiarisation period, during which you get to know your fellow students and the association in a fun and relaxed way.

In addition, R.S.G. is all about freedom. You decide how often you come by and how active you want to be. In your first year, there are a few moments when you are expected to participate, such as first-year duties, cooking, and bartending. That might sound exciting, but it is actually the perfect way to quickly get to know the association and your fellow members. Outside of those moments, you can shape your student life at R.S.G. completely your own way — no obligations, just opportunities. R.S.G. has existed for over 100 years (since 1921!). Over that time, many beautiful traditions and customs have developed that give our association its character. These traditions create an authentic student atmosphere and make the sociëteit a place where you quickly feel at home.

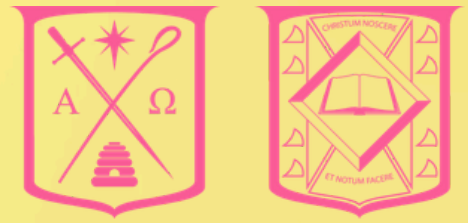
